The Brutus Stool has been carefully crafted to showcase the interplay between architectural strength and organic warmth. The solid oak construction enhances the sculptural quality, where sharp defined lines meet an elegant curved seat. The stool is part of the iconic 101 Copenhagen Brutus collection, which was inspired by the Brutalist architecture movement of the mid-20th century. The collection, which was first introduced in fiber concrete, has now been reimagined in solid FSC-certified American Red Oak, handmade by skilled craftsmen with a natural finish, highlighting the raw beauty and timeless appeal of the material itself.

Versatile in its function, the Brutus Stool can be used as additional seating, a side table, or a sculptural accent in the living room, hallway, or bedroom. Its compact form and timeless design make it easy to integrate into a variety of spaces, adding both practicality and character.

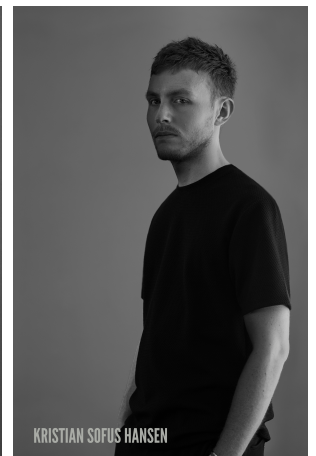
Designer Description

Together, they craft design that transcends time, poetic yet practical, expressive yet enduring.



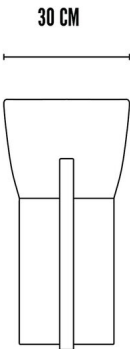
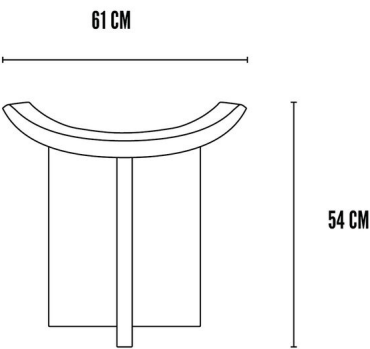

Family Description Text

The series is offered in two expressions, each highlighting different qualities of the design. In fiber concrete, the collection features a distinctive hand-painted surface that gives every piece its own unique texture. In wooden, the collection is reinterpreted to showcase organic warmth and timeless appeal. Together, the two expressions in fiber concrete and wooden capture the essence of Brutalism through contrasting qualities: one emphasizing raw, textured surfaces, the other highlighting natural warmth and refinement. Color Description

Natural Oak is a warm, golden-beige tone that reveals the authentic character of American Red Oak. Its subtle reddish undertones lend a gentle glow, while the grain adds natural rhythm and depth. Honest and timeless, this shade embodies the warmth of wood in its pure state, offering a versatile foundation that harmonizes with both modern and traditional settings.

Maintenance Guide Description

American Red Oak is a durable hardwood that matures beautifully, developing a rich patina over time. To maintain its character, dust surfaces regularly with a soft, dry cloth. For deeper cleaning, wipe gently with a slightly damp cloth in the direction of the grain, then dry immediately to prevent moisture from settling.

Avoid abrasive cleaners, silicone-based polishes, or excess water, as these can damage the surface or raise the grain. Protect oak with coasters, mats, or felt pads to prevent stains, scratches, and heat marks. Wipe spills promptly, and keep furniture away from direct sunlight, high humidity, or heat sources to prevent fading, cracking, or warping.

With mindful care, American Red Oak will preserve its natural strength and warmth, aging with quiet elegance and becoming richer in character over the years.
