Named after the Japanese word "Bakku," meaning "bag," the Bakku Vase embodies a distinctive, fluid form reminiscent of a softly collapsing sack.

The vase celebrates the beauty of imperfection, embracing natural curves and subtle variations that bring artistic elegance to any space. Expertly crafted using the age-old technique of mouth-blown glassmaking, the Bakku vase has been spray-painted the sophisticated hue of Smoked Desert, a soft, warm grey with delicate translucency, reminiscent of early morning mist.

Due to its artisanal craftsmanship, no two Bakku vases are exactly alike; small air bubbles or slight variations in shape make each piece truly one-of-a-kind.

The big Bakku vase makes a bold statement, whether showcasing vibrant blooms, sculptural branches, or standing alone as a striking glass centrepiece.

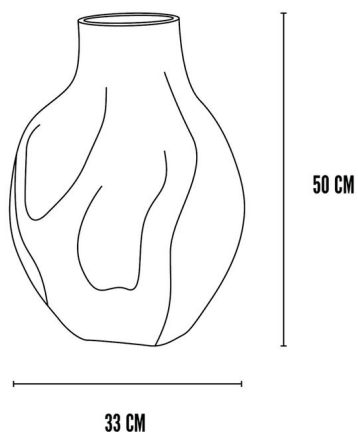

## Family Description Text

The Bakku Collection takes its name from the Japanese word "Bakku" meaning bag, yet its form speaks in the language of water and gravity. Each vase appears as if a droplet has fallen from the air, pulled earthward by its own weight. Rounded and heavy at the base, rising into a slim and gentle taper, it holds the quiet stillness of motion captured mid-fall.

Every Bakku vase embodies the poetry of imperfection. Subtle curves, gentle asymmetries, and delicate variations echo the unpredictable way water spreads when it lands, never twice the same, yet always beautiful in its surrender. These nuances transform each piece into a unique reflection of movement stilled in glass.

The Bakku Collection is not rigid form but captured motion, an ode to the moment where fluidity meets gravity, where softness becomes structure, and where a vessel holds not only flowers but also a story of balance, weight, and grace.

## Maintenance Guide Description

Though delicate in appearance, the glass is strong and durable, designed for everyday use in decorative and functional objects. To maintain its pristine look, we recommend regular cleaning with a soft microfiber cloth and a gentle glass cleaner or diluted soap solution. Spray the cleaner onto the cloth (not directly on the glass) and wipe in smooth, circular motions. Always dry with a clean cloth to prevent streaks or water marks. Avoid abrasive cleaners, scouring pads, or acidic substances, which can dull or damage the glossy surface. For tables, use coasters or felt pads under objects to prevent scratches or thermal shock from hot items. While the glass is moisture-resistant, it's best to avoid prolonged exposure to standing water or humidity, especially for vases empty and dry them between uses to preserve the finish. Elegant, minimal, and low-maintenance, our glass combines lasting beauty with functional design. With a little care, your table or vase will retain its distinctive charm for years to come.

## Materials Description

Our painted glass is created by applying pigment to the inner surface of the glass, a process that preserves the smooth clarity of the outer layer while enriching the material with depth and character. Though visually and tactilely identical to colored glass, the painted finish adds an artisanal dimension, with subtle variations that make each piece unique.

Durable yet refined, painted glass reflects light with the same purity and brilliance as coloured glass, offering a timeless surface that balances precision, craftsmanship, and contemporary expression.
